The Racing Calendar Office of Weatherbys Thoroughbred Ltd. receives entries submitted for acceptance as agents for the Racecourse Authority and only upon the terms of the Standard Conditions. Ryan, and Miss Nifty, ridden by R.P. Cleary where it appeared interference took place. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. G.M. Ryan stated that he felt pressure from both sides resulting in him catching the heel of Miss Nifty. B.M. Coen stated that he felt pressure from his inside forcing him onto horses outside of him. R.P. Whelan stated that his filly ran off the bend despite his best efforts to straighten her. R.P. Cleary stated that he moved inside of Pearl Jewel and felt he was clear of the horses inside him and therefore safe to do so and this was confirmed by G.M. Ryan. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards did not apportion blame to any rider and took no further action. In arriving at their decision, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that the incident was caused by La Dame Blanche drifting off her racing line, but they were satisfied that R.P. Whelan had made sufficient effort to avoid causing interference so they took no further action.

Crosse, placed sixth, Smaoineamh Sile (GB), ridden by R. Whearty, placed fourth, and Purple Sky, ridden by D.P. McDonogh, placed first, where it appeared Keilah suffered interference. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. N.M. Crosse stated that he received pressure from the outside and made contact with the rail. R. Whearty stated that he received slight pressure from his outside. G.F. Carroll stated that his mount was running freely and he shouted at D.P. McDonogh to come across him to get cover. D.P. McDonogh stated that he received a shout to come across but was unaware of the horse down the rail. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards found D.P. McDonogh was in breach of Rule 214 in that he had ridden carelessly.

Heffernan stated that his mount was green and shied away when the winner moved slightly. G.M. Ryan stated that his mount drifted out away from the horse inside him and he was not sure if there had been contact. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. D.P. McDonogh stated that his race was run and there was slight contact. G.F. Carroll stated that he was never going and there was marginal interference. L. Morris stated that he was taken off his intended line. R.L. Moore stated that he had caused the incident and apologised. He further added that as soon as he heard a shout he gave the ground back. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards found R.L. Moore was in breach of Rule 214 in that he had ridden carelessly. Having considered his record in this regard (first offence), the Raceday Stewards suspended him for one raceday. In arriving at their decision regarding penalty, the Raceday Stewards took into account that when R.L. **204H Visit Keadeenhotel.ie Irish European Breeders Fund (Fillies) M'dn** The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Guarded, trained by A.P. O'Brien, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be post race normal.
