Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards took no further action other than to remind J.A. Heffernan to react quicker if in a similar situation in future.

Mongey Communications Irish European Breeders Fund (Fillies) H'cap The Raceday Stewards enquired into an incident in the closing stages of this race involving Varshini, ridden by J.A. Heffernan, placed fifth, and Empress Artemis, ridden by Nicola Burns, placed second, where it appeared Empress Artemis drifted across Varshini. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. J.A. Heffernan stated that he did not have the horse to get into the gap and took a precautionary check. Nicola Burns stated that she kept straight. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards took no further action other than to remind Nicola Burns to ride with more awareness in future.

The Raceday Stewards requested a report from Stephen Thorne, trainer, as to the apparent improvement in form of Pink Oxalis, placed first, as compared with her most recent run. Mr Thorne stated that his charge failed to pick up on very holding and tacky ground last time out at Leopardstown and added that the drop back to a mile today had also helped to bring about the apparent improvement in form. Having considered the report, the Raceday Stewards noted the content of the report.

204C Al Shira'aa Racing Meadow Court Stakes The Raceday Stewards interviewed L. Morris, rider of Tasmania (GER), concerning his

use of the whip in the closing stages of this race. Evidence was heard from the rider concerned who accepted that he was in breach of the Regulation and apologised. Having viewed a recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that L. Morris was in breach of Regulation 10.3.h (arm above shoulder height). Having considered his record in this regard (first offence), the Raceday Stewards suspended him for two racedays.

The Raceday Stewards enquired into an incident turning in to the home straight involving Lemsairbat (FR), ridden by D.P. McDonogh, unplaced, Naomi Lapaglia (GB), ridden by G.F. Carroll, unplaced, Tasmania (GER), ridden by L. Morris, placed third, and Uluru, ridden by R.L. Moore, placed sixth, where it appeared Tasmania ran short of room and had to check. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. D.P. McDonogh stated that his race was run and there was slight contact. G.F. Carroll stated that he was never going and there was marginal interference. L. Morris stated that he was taken off his intended line. R.L. Moore stated that he had caused the incident and apologised. He further added that as soon as he heard a shout he gave the ground back. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards found R.L. Moore was in breach of Rule 214 in that he had ridden carelessly. Having considered his record in this regard (first offence), the Raceday Stewards suspended him for one raceday. In arriving at their decision regarding penalty, the Raceday Stewards took into account that when R.L. Moore initially looked he was clear and when Tasmania moved forward and the rider gave a shout he immediately yielded ground which mitigated the consequences of his actions.

G.M. Lyons, trainer of Naomi Lapaglia (GB), reported to the Clerk of Scales that his charge had suffered from heat stress post race. The IHRB Veterinary Officer confirmed that Naomi Lapaglia was showing signs of heat stress post race.

204D Romanised Minstrel Stakes A.J. Slattery, rider of Easy, trained by Andrew Slattery, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount rolled left inside the final furlong.

The Raceday Stewards enquired into an incident in the home straight involving Room Service, ridden by T. Eaves, unplaced, and Queen Of Thunder, placed sixth, ridden by C.D. Hayes where it appeared Room Service edged out into Queen Of Thunder. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. T. Eaves stated that his mount became unbalanced and stepped out, C.D. Haves stated that the horse on his inside rolled out and there was marginal contact. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards found T. Eaves was in breach of Rule 214 in that he had ridden carelessly. Having considered his record in this regard (first offence), the Raceday Stewards suspended him for two racedays.

204E Kwiff Home Of Supercharged Betting H'cap The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Valorous Power (GER), trained by Joseph Patrick O'Brien, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be post race normal.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Its All Peachy, trained by M.D. O'Callaghan, at the

request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be post race normal.

The Raceday Stewards enquired into an incident turning into the home straight involving Valorous Power (GER), ridden by D.P. McDonogh, placed sixth, Lady In Paris (GB), ridden by S. Foley, placed first, and Its All Peachy, ridden by K.G. Kennedy, placed fifth, where it appeared Its All Peachy ran short of room and had to check. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. D.P. McDonogh stated that he received slight contact from the horse on his inside. S. Foley stated that he moved half a horse width to deliver his challenge. K.G. Kennedy stated that his mount never travelled and as he edged out he had to take a precautionary check off heels. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards did not apportion blame to any rider and took no further action.

204F Kwiff Sponsors Supercharge Series H'cap Sorcha Woods, rider of Airspeed, trained by Edward Lynam, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that her mount had no run inside the last

K.G. Kennedy, rider of Billie Be Quick, trained by Mrs John Harrington, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount had no luck in running

204H Visit Keadeenhotel.ie Irish European Breeders Fund (Fillies) M'dn The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Guarded, trained by A.P. O'Brien, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be post race normal.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Treasure Rose, trained by J.P. Murtagh, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be post race normal.

R.L. Moore, rider of Guarded, trained by A.P. O'Brien, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount ran disappointingly and he could offer no reason why.

S. Foley, rider of Metamorphic (GB), trained by Mrs John Harrington, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount had no luck in running in the straight.

D.P. McDonogh, rider of Sunlight Dance, trained by J.S. Bolger, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount had to come off heels in the straight.

The Raceday Stewards enquired into an incident in the home straight involving Adrienne, ridden by C.D. Hayes, unplaced, Sunlight Dance, ridden by D.P. McDonogh, placed third, and Treasure Rose, ridden by B.M. Coen, unplaced, where it appeared Sunlight Dance had to switch. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. C.D. Hayes stated that he maintained a straight line. D.P. McDonogh stated that the horse in front of him stopped very quickly and he had to switch off heels. B.M. Coen stated that he caused no interference. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards took no further action.

Raceday Stewards informed Peter McCreery, trainer of Bhean Liath, that a repeat performance from his charge which was reluctant to load and reluctant to race, may render the animal liable for suspension in the future
