Important Notice

We were notified by DAFM in early October of a mandatory requirement that all horses for export must be on AIM's – DAFM's centralised Equine Database and the Equine Chip Checker <https://equine-chipcheck.apps.services.agriculture.gov.ie>

It is now a requirement as part of the export Application process to DAFM that a screenshot of the Equine chip checker results are included.

In advance of exporting a horse you must ensure:

- A. The animal exists on the Equine Chip Checker**
- B. That the food chain status reflects the passport**

A. If the horse is not on the Equine Chip Checker you must complete and submit the following to Weatherbys:

1. The passport
2. Completed change of ownership application (online or paper)
3. Valid Equine Premises number and Keeper details
4. Fee of €22

B. To update the Food Chain Status

Send the passport to Weatherbys or email a copy of the passport with the relevant pages (the pedigree page, medicinal/administration of medical products page) to studbookireland@weatherbys.ie and the subject line should read "*Urgent Update to Fit for Human Consumption Status*".

Important to note: Horses with foreign country codes such as GB, FR, GER, USA, ITY, etc. they will not be on AIM's until a change of ownership has been submitted and completed by Weatherbys Ireland.

The above is to be lodged within 30 days of acquiring the animal applicable under SI 201 of 2016.

WHEN SELLING / TRANSFERRING OWNERSHIP:

- Give the passport to the buyer / new owner at the time of the sale
- A record of the transfer of ownership of an equine shall be maintained by both the person transferring ownership and the person to whom ownership is transferred.

WHEN BUYING / ACQUIRING OWNERSHIP:

- You must receive the passport from the seller at the time of purchase.
- You must complete this transfer of ownership form.
- You must forward this form and the passport with the appropriate fee to the PIO within 30 days of taking ownership.

RECORDS / PENALTIES

- Both parties must keep a copy of this transfer of ownership declaration - photocopying or photo will suffice.

- DAFM authorised officers will carry out inspections and have powers to inspect records and documents.
- Failure to register the transfer of ownership within the time limit is now a serious offence in Ireland and attracts heavy penalties.
- Giving false, misleading or incomplete information is also a legal offence.

REGISTERED PREMISES:

- It is a legal requirement under the Control on Places where Horses are kept Regulation (SI 113 of 2014) that all premises where equines are kept must be registered with the Department of Agriculture. Accordingly, you should ensure that your equine is being kept on a registered premises. If your holding is not already registered as an Equine Premises, you should apply immediately to DAFM for an Equine Premises Number.

SECTION F - DECLARATION

Weatherbys respects the rights to privacy of all its clients. Weatherbys will need to use the information provided by you for its own internal administration and analysis. It may use the information in support of bonus/premium schemes which are in the direct interests of breeders. The information may be uploaded to official resources when required by law i.e. DAFM.
