TRANSITION TO WHITE OBSTACLES

The introduction of white obstacles will be
phased to allow tracks that host Summer
National Hunt racing the opportunity to
complete the 2025 season with their existing
obstacles.

From 20 September 2025, white obstacles will
begin to be introduced.

The rollout schedule is as follows:

- Clonmel – 2 October: New Traditional

- Gowran – 3 October: Onefit Padded

- Fairyhouse – 11 October: New
Traditional Style Easyfix Hurdle
- Cork – 12 October: New Traditional
Style Easyfix Hurdle

- Thurles – 16 October: New
Traditional Style Easyfix Hurdle
- Limerick – 18 October: New
Traditional Style Easyfix Hurdle
- Down Royal – 31 October: New

Please note that fences will also change to
white in line with the hurdles at all the above
meetings. All other racecourses will continue to
use their existing orange hurdles until their final
fixture of 2025, with Wexford on 27 October
2025 staging the last meeting in Ireland to be
run over orange obstacles.

During October, several fixtures will continue to
use orange obstacles, including Sligo on 1 and
24 October, Tipperary on 5 and 6 October,
Galway on 7, 25 and 26 October, Downpatrick
on 10 October, and Wexford on 26 and 27
October.

The Curragh training grounds have already
commenced conversion. All obstacles on the
schooling strip (hurdles and fences) are now
white, with full transition across the grounds to
be completed during the Autumn.

IRISH HORSERACING REGULATORY BOARD

On the 3 September 2025, the Directors of
the IHRB approved the following changes to
Regulation 16 (page 198) which will become
effective on 3 September 2025:

PROCEDURE FOR MOUNTING IN PARADE RING

The following procedures shall be adopted at all
Racecourses.

Upon the official signal to mount, Riders shall
be present in the parade ring and Trainers must
ensure that the Rider mount the Horse on the
walk without undue delay, ensuring the Horse
continues to proceed around the parade ring.
Horses shall not cross the parade ring except
with the permission of an IHRB Official.

Trainers are responsible for all staff in ensuring
they comply with all Rules, Regulations and
Procedures.

Any Trainer or Rider who fails to comply, or
whose conduct contributes to a failure to
comply, shall be liable to sanction and such fine
as deemed appropriate.

IRISH HORSERACING REGULATORY BOARD

On the 3 September 2025, the Directors of
the IHRB approved the following changes to
Regulation 10 (page 180/181) which will
become effective on 3 September 2025:

HELMETS (former Skull Caps)

All Helmets must comply with at least two
different international helmet testing standards
and carry evidence of quality testing from
recognised organisations. Further guidance on
approved standards and testing requirements is
available at [www.ihrb.ie/jockey-safety-
information](http://www.ihrb.ie/jockey-safety-information)

All Riders, when mounted on a Horse, must
wear a Helmet that:

- It is of the correct size for the Rider,
in serviceable condition, with the chin
strap properly adjusted and always
fastened when mounted.
- Must not have a chin cup, cradle, or
draw lace; the chin strap must pass
under the jaw and be secured by a
quick-release buckle. Metal hooks
are expressly forbidden.
- Any Helmet subjected to severe
impact, or worn by a Rider who has
suffered concussion, must be
replaced.

An IHRB Medical Officer or the Chief Medical
Officer may direct replacement after inspection.

IRISH HORSERACING REGULATORY BOARD

On the 3 September 2025, the Directors of
the IHRB approved the following changes to
Definitions and Academy Hurdles which will
become effective on 3 September 2025:

Rule 1 (ii) Definitions

"Academy Hurdle" is a hurdle race confined to
3yo horses that have not run in any Race other
than such a race or a Junior N. H. Hurdle in
Great Britain as a 3yo.

"Irish National Hunt Flat Race" (which may be
referred to and known as an I.N.H. Flat Race) is
a Flat Race run under the I.N.H.S. Rules [text
deleted].

"Maiden"

- for Races under the Rules of Racing
is a Horse which has not won a Flat
Race under any recognised Rules of
Racing;

- b) for Races under the I.N.H.S. Rules is a Horse which has not won a Steeplechase or Hurdle Race other than an Academy Hurdle or Junior N.H. Hurdle in Great Britain as a 3yo, an I.N.H. Flat Race or National Hunt Flat Race, a match or private sweepstakes, or a Steeplechase at a Point to Point Meeting, at any Recognised Meeting in any country. Unless otherwise stated a maiden means a maiden at the time of starting.

Rule 79 I.N.H. Flat Races [text deleted]

Irish National Hunt Steeplechase Regulations for Point to Point Steeplechases

The Directors of the INHSC & IHRB using their powers under Rule 22 have modified **Regulations 8 (i)(b), 23 (b)(v), (vi), 28, ION 3 4. & 14. (iii)** and introduced **ION 15** to the Irish National Hunt Steeplechase Regulations for Point to Point Steeplechases to read as follows:

The modifications are underlined and will come into effect on 18 September 2025.

8. (i) (b) A Horse shall not be qualified to start for a Point to Point Steeplechase in the Spring schedule if it has:

won a race under any Rules of Racing or Steeplechasing (Hunters Steeplechases, any race under the Regulations for Point to Point Steeplechases in Ireland or Great Britain and Private Sweepstakes excluded) on or after March 1st prior to the start of the current Point to Point season; or

run in any race under the Rules of Racing or Steeplechasing (Hunters Steeplechases, any race under the Regulations for Point to Point Steeplechases in Ireland or Great Britain, Academy Hurdles and Private Sweepstakes excluded) on or after December 1st of the current Point to Point season.

Where in the case of (i) (a) above a Hunters Certificate has already been issued for a Horse and it subsequently runs in a race under any Rules of Racing or Steeplechasing (Hunters Steeplechases, any race under the Regulations for Point to Point Steeplechases in Ireland or Great Britain and Private Sweepstakes excluded), between September 1st and November 30th of the current Point to Point Season, the Hunters Certificate shall automatically be suspended until the commencement of the Spring Schedule.

Where in the case of (i) (a) and (b) above a Horse runs in a race under any Rules of Racing or Steeplechasing (Hunters Steeplechases, any race under the Regulations for Point to Point Steeplechases in Ireland or Great Britain, Academy Hurdles and Private Sweepstakes excluded), on or after December 1st of the current Point to Point Season the Hunters Certificate shall automatically be cancelled for the remainder of the season.

23. (b) **Riders**
- (v) A Rider, who is also a Handler, may not ride in a Point to Point Steeplechase against a horse they train, unless they are riding a horse they also train.
- (vi) All Riders, when mounted on a Horse, must wear a helmet that:
- (a) It is of the correct size for the Rider, in serviceable condition, with the chin strap properly adjusted and always fastened when mounted.
- (b) Must not have a chin cup, cradle, or draw lace; the chin strap must pass under the jaw and be secured by a quick-release buckle. Metal hooks are expressly forbidden.
- (c) Any helmet subjected to severe impact, or worn by a Rider who has suffered concussion, must be replaced.

An IHRB Medical Officer or the Chief Medical Officer may direct replacement after inspection.

All helmets must comply with at least two different international helmet testing standards and carry evidence of quality testing from recognised organisations. Further guidance on approved standards and testing requirements is available at www.ihrb.ie/jockey-safety-information

28. No whip or substitute for a whip, bridle, rings, plates or anything worn on a Horse's legs, cap or helmet, Hood, Sheepskin Cheek Pieces, Tongue Strap, muzzle, martingale, breastplate or number cloth shall be allowed in the scales either in weighing out or weighing in.

ION 3 Fences

4. Toe boards and knee boards must be white.

Regulation Fences

14. (iii) Toe boards should be at least 12 to 14 in. in height and 3 in. thick and the front edge should be rounded. They should be white [text deleted] and securely fixed about two in. below ground level and five ft. from the front of the fence.

ION 15

Horse's Equipment

In the interests of safety, a Horse must be equipped with a bridle or a chifney which may be attached to a head collar other than when in a horsebox or stabled, or when in a horsebox or stabled at the direction of an IHRB Official

The Racing Calendar Office of Weatherbys Thoroughbred Ltd. receives entries submitted for acceptance as agents for the Racecourse Authority and only upon the terms of the Standard Conditions. Acceptance of entries is subject to the power to refuse to allow entries to be accepted conferred by the Orders and Rules of Racing on the British Horseracing Authority Ltd. Entries are accepted by the Racing Calendar Office, acting as aforesaid, causing the name of the horse in question to be published as being entered for the race in question either in The Racing Calendar, when the race closes more than six days before running, or, for other races, on the British Horseracing Authority Racing Administration Internet site (www.racingadmin.co.uk) and ordinarily in the Sporting Press.

FRANCE - Owners and trainers of horses trained outside of France are reminded that, to enter any horse in a French race for the first time, they must register their horses in training through their access online at least 8 days before the closing time of entry, with the correct name of the horse, its suffix, sex, year of foaling and pedigree (sire, dam and sire of dam).

This declaration is not considered as an entry. Trainers are to make their entries and other declarations directly online. They must also supply a complete race record of all the performances of the horse(s) entered on the Internet, by fax (33 1 47 61 93 37) or email (fgperf@france-galop.com). The entry will not be valid if these performances are not received by the international department at Racing Operations by the time of the first forfeit, or on the eve of the declaration to run (if entries were made more than a month before the race). When declaring a horse to run, it is the responsibility of the trainer to check the weight carried.

Italy - Owners and trainers of horses trained outside Italy are informed that, the first time they enter any horse to run in Italy, they must include with the entry the correct name, sex, year of foaling, pedigree (sire, dam and sire of dam) and the name of the country where the horse was foaled.

Horses and those in charge of them are received on the terms that the Executive and the Stewards of the respective Meetings are not to be liable for any damage, loss or injury to such horses or persons while in or about the stabling or on the Course from any cause whatsoever.

Nominations can only be made and accepted on the condition that the nominator subjects himself/herself, in all respects to the Rules & HRI Directives under which each race is run. Races and divisions are run subject to the provisions of HRI Directive 9..

Handicap races closing under the Irish entry system will be calculated at the time of closing. The rating qualification will take into account all performances up to and including the **Sunday** previous to the rating qualification date.

In accordance with Rule 101 (ii), the Qualifying Ratings shall be calculated on each Monday at 12 noon. The Qualifying Rating for each horse shall be equivalent to the horse's current Rating at that time.

Qualifying Ratings For Flat Races

For the purposes of qualification for flat handicaps, in the event of a horse being assigned a separate handicap mark for "all weather" handicaps, the "all weather" qualification rating will be the horse's qualifying rating for "all weather" racing. In the event of a horse being assigned only one handicap rating, the same qualifying rating shall apply for qualification purposes to handicaps run on both turf and "all weather" surfaces.

'Novice' for hurdle races is a horse which has not won a hurdle race prior to 4th May 2025 and for steeplechases is a horse which has not won a steeplechase prior to 4th May 2025, other than one hunter steeplechase within the previous two National Hunt seasons. However, any horse which wins a hurdle race for the first time or a steeplechase (hunter steeplechase excluded) for the first time between 1st February 2025 and 3rd May 2025, will be qualified as a 'Novice' for the period up to and including 30th November 2025 other than the winner of a Grade 1 Weight For Age Hurdle or Steeplechase prior to 4th May 2025.

Overnight Nomination Of Rider & Colours

Under Rule 195, it is compulsory to nominate a rider for each declared horse by 12 noon on the day that Declarations close. The trainer must declare any intended change of colours or any colours in use that are not registered with Horse Racing Ireland for racecard purposes. In such instances the declaration of colours must be made to Horse Racing Ireland by 12 noon on the day the declarations close unless otherwise stated.

Flat race, first, second, third, fourth or fifth in a Hurdle race or first, second, third or fourth in a Point-to-Point Steeplechase in Ireland or Great Britain prior to 23rd April, 2026, with the order of elimination at the discretion of the N.H. Handicapper.

(iii) In the event of (ii) not achieving the recommended limit, the elimination of the remaining runners will be at the discretion of the N.H. Handicapper.

The Handicapper's decision shall be final (International performances will be taken into account and the latest date for assessment by the Handicapper will be 10 a.m. on Thursday, 23rd April, 2026).

277B SIS, Supporting Irish Racing H'cap H'dle The Raceday Stewards enquired into an incident shortly after jumping the second last involving Kazakh D'arhel (FR), ridden by Conor Stone-Walsh, placed fourth, Lady Doyanne, ridden by Darragh O'Keefe, unplaced, and Quint Major, ridden by Danny Gilligan, unplaced, where it appeared interference had occurred. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. Danny Gilligan stated that he kept a straight line and received pressure from his outside. Conor Stone-Walsh stated that he was in the gap when he received pressure. Darragh O'Keefe stated that he maintained his line. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards found Conor Stone-Walsh was in breach of Rule 214 in that he had ridden carelessly. Having considered his clean record

in this regard, the Raceday Stewards suspended him for two racedays.

277C Bar One Racing M'dn H'dle The Raceday Stewards interviewed Calum Hogan, rider of County Final, concerning his use of the whip in the closing stages of this race. Evidence was heard from the rider concerned who accepted he was in breach of the whip Regulation and apologised for his actions. Furthermore, he stated that he thought he heard a horse close behind him. Having viewed a recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that Calum Hogan was in breach of R.10.3(c)(unnecessary use of the whip when the race is clearly won). Having considered his clean record in this regard, they suspended him for two racedays.

Ben Harvey, rider of Mighty Rosa, trained by Cian Collins, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount burst a blood vessel. This was subsequently confirmed by the IHRB Veterinary Officer.

277D(i) Balreask Bar, Restaurant & Guest H'cap H'dle (Division One) The Raceday Stewards enquired into an incident on the bend shortly after jumping the third last hurdle involving Head For Home, ridden by Phillip Enright, unplaced, and Rebelle Chaud, ridden by Shane O'Callaghan, unplaced, where it appeared Head For Home had to check. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. Phillip Enright stated that it was tight for a stride after Rebelle Chaud rolled in. Shane O'Callaghan stated that his mount rolled in a small bit on the point of the bend despite his best efforts. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards took no further action other than to remind Shane O'Callaghan to ride with more awareness in future.

277F Start Your Racing TV Ladies H'cap H'dle The Raceday Stewards interviewed Anna McGuinness, rider of Big Debates (FR), concerning her use of the whip in the closing stages of this race. Evidence was heard from the rider concerned who stated that her mount was pricking his ears and trying to pull himself up in the last furlong. Having viewed a recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that Anna McGuinness was in breach of R.10.3(c) (unnecessary use of the whip when the race is clearly won). Having considered her clean record in this regard, they suspended her for two racedays.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer reported to the Raceday Stewards that Mazza's Mahler, trained by Rory Anthony Devine, was found to have burst a blood vessel.

Hamilton, that Daniel King, rider of Drumgill, Sean Flanagan, rider of Embittered, Darragh O'Keeffe, rider of Jasko Des Dames (FR), Eoin Staples, rider of Dutch Schultz (GB) and Phillip Enright, rider of Battle Of Ridgeway had failed to obey the instructions he was giving in the first false start.
