IHRB Notice to Trainers

Rule 91 (Equine Influenza Vaccinations – New Time Intervals)

In order to ensure that horses remain compliant with the new time intervals contained in Rule 91, please note the following:

For horses which have been vaccinated with a valid first vaccination (V1) before 1st January 2022 the following shall apply:

- Horses which received a V3 or annual booster, between 1st January 30th June 2022 will require a booster vaccination on or before 31st December 2022 in order to be compliant by 1st January 2023 (a vaccination cannot be administered within the previous 7 days of a raceday or the horse will not be qualified to start)
- Horses which receive a V3 or annual booster, from and including 1st July 2022 must receive a booster vaccination within each succeeding six-month period

For Horses which have been vaccinated with a valid first vaccination (V1) on or after 1st January 2022 the following applies:

- V1 V2 21 60 days
- V2 V3 120 180 days
- Boosters Not more than six months apart

Booster vaccinations should be administered no more than six months apart, according to calendar months rather than a fixed number of days.

Examples of potential month end scenarios are included in the table below.
