APOLOGY TO PAUL CALLAN SC Monanny Farm, County Monaghan

The Irish Horseracing Regulatory Board ("IHRB") has promulgated the contents of the decision of the Appeals Body given on 17th May 2023 against a refusal of the Licensing Committee to grant a training licence to Samantha Finnegan, which decision was made on 2nd February 2023.

The report is on the IHRB website and it was published in the Irish Racing Calendar on 1st June 2023. The original decision contained criticisms relating to premises owned by Mr Paul Callan SC at Monanny Farm, County Monaghan. These criticisms should not have been made nor should they have been reported on. No issue in relation to his premises was raised before the Licensing Committee nor was it an issue set out by either party prior to the hearing at the Appeal Body. The IHRB believes that the inclusion of this commentary in this decision was incorrect and inappropriate and accordingly has now redacted same from all relevant online publications.

The IHRB apologises to Mr Paul Callan for the undoubted upset and inconvenience that the inclusion of these comments have caused him. The IHRB confirms that no issues have been raised with it in relation to the standards that Mr Paul Callan SC maintains in his equine farm enterprise.

Notice Received From France Galop

ART. 111 - ENTRY FOR FOREIGN-TRAINED HORSES

"In order for a foreign-trained horse to be entered in a public race in France for the first time, the horse must be duly declared by the trainer on the France Galop website **at least 15 days prior to the day of the race** in which the horse is due to take part. This declaration must include its full designation including name, sex, year of foaling, coat, breeding (sire, dam, dam's sire) and the suffix of the country of birth. Furthermore, if the race takes place more than 15 days after the entry closing, the declaration above must be made no later than the day before the general entry closing day. If an entry is not registered due to a non-compliance with this provision, no appeal may be lodged."

Appeals & Referrals

Referral

The Referrals Committee, Mr. Anthony Byrne (Chair), Mr. Noel McCaffrey and Dr. Tom McDonogh convened at the Offices of the Irish Horseracing Regulatory Board on Tuesday, 22nd August 2023 to consider the referral of T.E. Hyde (Trainer) by the Raceday Stewards at Listowel on Monday, 5th of June 2023.

Following the running of the Beasley Engineering Hunters Steeplechase, the Raceday Stewards received a complaint from the IHRB Veterinary Officer, Ms. Nicola O'Connor, that the horse All Hell Let Loose was attended to and given veterinary attention in the stable yard by a person unauthorised to do so on the day without the consultation of the IHRB Veterinary Officer's on duty. This is an act of Veterinary Medicine that could only be carried out with the express permission of the IHRB Veterinary Officer. Having considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards referred this matter to a Senior Racing Official for further investigation. The matter was subsequently referred to the Referrals Committee for hearing.

At the Referral Hearing, evidence was heard from Mr. Tim Hyde, Authorised Representative of Mr. T.E. Hyde, who was present at Listowel. The Referrals Committee also watched Racecourse Stable Yard CCTV footage of the day in question.

In his evidence, Mr. Hyde explained that All Hell Let Loose is a family-owned horse which predominantly races in Point to Points to give his sons experience of riding in races. Mr. Hyde added that the run in Listowel was to be the last run of the season. He said that the horse ran well on the day but sustained a cut above his knee and that this was washed and stapled post-race in the Racecourse Stable Yard by Ms. Carolyn Hyde, a veterinary surgeon registered to practise in Ireland. Mr. Hyde added that antibiotics were also being prepared for administration to the horse but were not administered. Mr. Hyde admitted that they had acted in haste in treating the horse, due to concern regarding the injury, rather than bringing the injury to the attention of the IHRB or directly to the raceday veterinary teams, who are responsible for veterinary treatment in Racecourse Stable Yard on the day of a Race Meeting. Mr Hyde confirmed that Mr. T. E. Hyde, Trainer, accepted that he was in breach of Regulation 9.

Having considered the evidence, the Referrals Committee found Mr. T. E. Hyde in breach of Regulation 9 in that treatment had been administered to a horse under his care and control in the Racecourse Stable Yard on the day of a Race Meeting without the express permission of the IHRB Veterinary Officer. Having considered the nature of the breach and the presence of antibiotics in the Racecourse Stable Yard without permission, and noting that Mr. Hyde's record was clear, the Referrals Committee imposed a fine of €1,500.

Mr. Hyde was represented by Mr. Kevin Power, Maurice Power Solicitors, Kilmallock, Co. Limerick. The IHRB was represented by Mr. Michael Daly, IHRB Regulatory Legal Advisor.

Appeal

The Appeals Body, Mr. Anthony Byrne (Chair), Mr. Noel McCaffrey and Dr. Tom McDonogh convened at the Offices of the Irish Horseracing Regulatory Board on Tuesday, 22nd August 2023 to consider the appeal of Conor Stone-Walsh (Rider) following the decision of the Raceday Stewards at the Curragh on Sunday, 13th of August 2023.

Following the running of the La Celia Wines Handicap, the Raceday Stewards found Mr. Stone-Walsh, rider of Roaring Gallagher, in breach of Rule 214 in that he had ridden carelessly and having considered his record in this regard they suspended him for three racedays.

The grounds of appeal lodged by Mr. Stone-Walsh was that the Raceday Stewards erred in their decision.

At the Appeal Hearing, evidence was heard from Mr. Stone-Walsh. The Appeals Body also watched a recording of the race.

In his evidence, Mr. Stone-Walsh explained that he had come from the back of the field with a challenge, a gap appeared to open and as he committed to the gap a horse came in from his outside causing him to take a check and to come out of the gap. Mr. Stone-Walsh further stated that it was his opinion that any interference was not caused by his riding manoeuvre.

Having considered the evidence, the Appeals Body dismissed the appeal and confirmed the suspension imposed on the day.

Mr. Stone-Walsh represented himself at the appeal hearing. The IHRB was represented by Mr. Michael Daly, IHRB Regulatory Legal Advisor.
