Notice Received From France Galop

ART. 111 - ENTRY FOR FOREIGN-TRAINED HORSES

"In order for a foreign-trained horse to be entered in a public race in France for the first time, the horse must be duly declared by the trainer on the France Galop website **at least 15 days prior to the day of the race** in which the horse is due to take part. This declaration must include its full designation including name, sex, year of foaling, coat, breeding (sire, dam, dam's sire) and the suffix of the country of birth. Furthermore, if the race takes place more than 15 days after the entry closing, the declaration above must be made no later than the day before the general entry closing day. If an entry is not registered due to a non-compliance with this provision, no appeal may be lodged."

Irish Horseracing Regulatory Board Notice

Declaration Of Non-Runners & Reserves

Trainers are requested to note that notifications of a non-runner or declaration of a reserve **can now be done via RAS** or on the dedicated telephone line (045-445645) at the Office of the I.H.R.B. up to 90 minutes before the time of the first race.

If using the Non-Runner/Reserve Telephone Line, the caller will be asked to provide the Trainer's Horse Racing Ireland account number and Trainer's date of birth. All calls are recorded for verification and security purposes. Veterinary certificates, where required, must be sent as usual to the Office of the IHRB within 72 hours. A Trainer failing to lodge a certificate within the time period shall be liable to a fine in accordance with Rule 194(v)(vi).

Trainers wishing to declare a Reserve a runner or a non-runner must also do so **via RAS** or on the same dedicated telephone line number by **10am for meetings, (other than floodlit meetings) during the months of November, December and January** and by 11am for all other meetings including floodlit meetings otherwise the reserve will automatically be withdrawn.

If a rider has not been nominated for a declared reserve the Trainer must do so by the time fixed for declaration of a reserve listed within the paragraph above otherwise the declared reserve will automatically be withdrawn.

Declaration of reserves or of non-runners are no longer accepted at a race meeting.

Updates can be made **via RÁS anytime after the publication of Rider Nominations for the meeting up to the specified deadlines**.

The dedicated line number (045 - 445645) is in operation from 9am on weekdays when there is a Race Meeting **and from 8.30am on weekends and Bank Holidays in November, December and January**.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

The Racing Calendar Office of Weatherbys Thoroughbred Ltd. receives entries submitted for acceptance as agents for the Racecourse Authority and only upon the terms of the Standard Conditions. Acceptance of entries is subject to the power to refuse to allow entries to be accepted conferred by the Orders and Rules of Racing on the British Horseracing Authority Ltd. Entries are accepted by the Racing Calendar Office, acting as aforesaid, causing the name of the horse in question to be published as being entered for the race in question either in The Racing Calendar, when the race closes more than six days before running, or, for other races, on the British Horseracing Authority Racing Administration Internet site (www.racingadmin.co.uk) and ordinarily in the Sporting Press.

FRANCE - Owners and trainers of horses trained outside of France are reminded that, to enter any horse in a French race for the first time, they must register their horses in training through their access online at least 8 days before the closing time of entry, with the correct name of the horse, its suffix, sex, year of foaling and pedigree (sire, dam and sire of dam).

This declaration is not considered as an entry. Trainers are to make their entries and other declarations directly online. They must also supply a complete race record of all the performances of the horse(s) entered on the Internet, by fax (33 1 47 61 93 37) or email (fgperf@france-galop.com). The entry will not be valid if these performances are not received by the international department at Racing Operations by the time of the first forfeit, or on the eve of the declaration to run (if entries were made more than a month before the race). When declaring a horse to run, it is the responsibility of the trainer to check the weight carried.

Italy - Owners and trainers of horses trained outside Italy are informed that, the first time they enter any horse to run in Italy, they must include with the entry the correct name, sex, year of foaling, pedigree (sire, dam and sire of dam) and the name of the country where the horse was foaled.

Horses and those in charge of them are received on the terms that the Executive and the Stewards of the respective Meetings are not to be liable for any damage, loss or injury to such horses or persons while in or about the stabling or on the Course from any cause whatsoever.

Nominations can only be made and accepted on the condition that the nominator subjects himself/herself, in all respects to the Rules & HRI Directives under which each race is run.

Races and divisions are run subject to the provisions of Rule 20.

Handicap races closing under the Irish entry system will be calculated at the time of closing. The rating qualification will take into account all performances up to and including the **Sunday** previous to the rating qualification date.

In accordance with Rule 101 (iv), the Qualifying Ratings shall be calculated on each Monday at 12 noon. The Qualifying Rating for each horse shall be equivalent to the horse's current Rating at that time.

Qualifying Ratings For Flat Races

For the purposes of qualification for flat handicaps, in the event of a horse being assigned a separate handicap mark for "all weather" handicaps, the "all weather" qualification rating will be the horse's qualifying rating for "all weather" racing. In the event of a horse being assigned only one handicap rating, the same qualifying rating shall apply for qualification purposes to handicaps run on both turf and "all weather" surfaces.

Entries & Declarations

Entries for horses trained outside of Ireland must be made through the relevant Turf Authority and close by 11am on the same day they close with Horse Racing Ireland. Entries for early closing races are accepted through the relevant Turf Authorities on the same day they close with Horse Racing Ireland at 12 noon.

All trainers licenced in Ireland can only make declarations by the following methods: a) Online RAS System b) Telephone (045 455422).

For the purpose of the 2023/2024 National Hunt season:-

'Novice' for hurdle races is a horse which has not won a hurdle race prior to 30th April, 2023 and for steeplechases is a horse which has not won a steeplechase prior to 30th April, 2023 other than one hunter steeplechase within the previous two National Hunt seasons. However, any horse which wins a hurdle race for the first time or a steeplechase (hunter steeplechase excluded) for the first time between 1st February, 2023 and 29th April, 2023 will be qualified as a 'Novice' for the period up to and including 3rd December, 2023 other than the winner of a Grade 1 Weight For Age Hurdle or Steeplechase prior to 30th April, 2023.

Overnight Nomination Of Rider & Colours

Under Rule 195, it is compulsory to nominate a rider for each declared horse by 12 noon on the day that Declarations close. Under Rule 155 the trainer must declare any intended change of colours or any colours in use that are not registered with Horse Racing Ireland for racecard purposes. In such instances the declaration of colours must be made to Horse Racing Ireland by 12 noon on the day the declarations close unless otherwise stated.

Quirke stated that he saw Ninth Loch drifting across and took a precautionary check. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards took no further action.

At the request of the Raceday Stewards, G.B. Noonan, rider of Boxcar Molly, trained by Eoin Christopher McCarthy, reported to the Stewards' Secretaries that his mount was keen early on and flattened out.

At the request of the Raceday Stewards, S.W. Flanagan, rider of Showman (GB), trained by Peter Fahey, reported to the Stewards' Secretaries that his mount was keen early on and stayed on past tired horses.

283D(i) Kathleen Walsh Memorial H'cap H'dle (Division One) The IHRB Veterinary Officer reported to the Raceday Stewards that Gekkota (FR) trained by T.J. O'Mara was found to have blood at both nostrils post race.

The Raceday Stewards requested a report from E. McNamara, trainer, as to the apparent improvement in form of Millstream Lady, placed first, as compared with her most recent below par form. E. McNamara stated that his charge relishes the softer ground as opposed to the good ground she encountered at Killarney most

recently. Having considered the report, the Raceday Stewards noted its content.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer reported to the Raceday Stewards that Indie Belle trained by Robert Widger was lame on her right fore post race.

283D(ii) Kathleen Walsh Memorial H'cap H'dle (Division Two) J.G. Gilligan, rider of Mac's Xpress, trained by Paul John Gilligan, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount hung left up the home straight.

S.D. Torrens, rider of Gonetomillgrove, trained by P.J. Rothwell, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount burst a blood vessel in this race. This was subsequently confirmed by the IHRB Veterinary Officer.

The Raceday Stewards enquired into the closing stages of this race where all horses finished bypassing the last hurdle as instructed and finished on the inner track. Evidence was heard from the IHRB Clerk Of The Course, Mr. P. Moloney, who stated that if the last hurdle needed to be bypassed the riders were instructed to follow procedures and finish on the inner track. Having heard the evidence and considered the matter, the Raceday Stewards allowed the result to stand and took no further action.

At the request of the Raceday Stewards, J.G. Gilligan, rider of Mac's Xpress, trained by Paul John Gilligan, reported to the Stewards' Secretaries that his mount was hanging turning in and ran up onto heels.

283E Charlie Chute Memorial H'cap S'chase

The Raceday Stewards enquired into an incident at the fourth last fence involving Upping The Anti, ridden by Rachael Blackmore, and Brideswell Lad, ridden by J.J. Slevin where it appeared Brideswell Lad stumbled before the fence. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. Rachael Blackmore stated that she maintained a straight line on approach to the fence. J.J. Slevin stated that his mount stumbled independently. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards took no further action.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer reported to the Raceday Stewards that Brideswell Lad, trained by Seamus Neville, was found to have blood at both nostrils post race.

Mr F. Maguire, rider of Holiday In Kerry, trained by E. McNamara, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount finished lame.

285A Irish EBF Median Sires Series M'dn W.J. Lee, rider of Gibbs Island (GB), trained by A. Oliver, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount rolled around when he reached the front.

The Raceday Stewards enquired into an incident inside the final furlong involving Auguste Lumiere, ridden by L.T. McAteer, unplaced, Surfers Paradise, ridden by D.P. McDonogh, unplaced, Nitti, ridden by C.T. Keane, placed fifth, Hazbaiya, ridden by B.M. Coen, placed sixth, and Glimmerglass, ridden by N.G. McCullagh, unplaced, where it appeared L.T. McAteer had to check his mount. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. In his evidence, L.T. McAteer stated that his mount was getting tired when it became a little tight for room and he took a precautionary check. D.P. McDonogh stated that he received slight pressure from his inside. C.T. Keane stated that his mount went a bit right, but that he corrected him quickly and he stayed straight to the line. B.M. Coen stated that the wind was hitting them side on and that his mount was tiring and rolling around on the soft ground. N.G. McCullagh stated that there was a strong wind and that his mount was rolling around and getting tired. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards could not apportion blame to any rider and so took no further action. Mr. M.C. Hickey recused himself from this enquiry.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Surfers Paradise, trained by Joseph Patrick O'Brien, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be post race normal.

285D Fitzpatrick's Garage Group Nursery H'cap J.A. Powell, rider of Promo Queen, trained by Christopher David Timmons, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount hung right from the halfway mark.

The Raceday Stewards enquired into possible interference inside the last two furlongs involving Vestigia, ridden by R.C. Colgan, placed second, and Promo Queen, ridden by J.A. Powell, placed first, where it appeared interference may have occurred. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. In his evidence, R.C. Colgan stated that his mount received pressure from his outside and was bumped which caused him to lose momentum. J.A. Powell stated that his mount started to hang in two furlongs down, but he straightened her as best he could. He felt he kept her straight inside the last furlong. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards were of the opinion that while Promo Queen had caused interference to Vestigia, she did not improve her finishing position as a result of this interference. They therefore made no alteration to the Judge's placings and took no further action.

R.C. Colgan, rider of Vestigia, trained by Ms. Sheila Lavery, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount was hampered by the winner on the run in.

285E Westgrove Hotel Renaissance Stakes R.P. Cleary, rider of Clever And Cool, trained by J.S. Bolger, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount was slowly away from the starting stalls.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Ocean Quest, trained by Mrs John Harrington, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be post race normal.

285G Friends Of The Curragh Irish Cesarewitch The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Echoes In Rain (FR), trained by W.P. Mullins, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be post race normal.

J. Kearney, rider of Weston (GER), trained by Gordon Elliott, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount lost his action in the straight.

N.G. McCullagh, rider of Drop The Anchor, trained by P.A. Fahy, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount stumbled after two furlongs from hitting a ridge.

J.A. Powell, rider of My Mate Mozzie, trained by Gavin Cromwell, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount was short of room in the last half furlong.

The Raceday Stewards requested a report from Joseph Patrick O'Brien, trainer, as to the apparent improvement in form of Magellan Strait, placed first, as compared with his recent form. Joseph Patrick O'Brien stated that his charge does not like being crowded in his races and a wide draw with a good start contributed to today's improvement in form. The Raceday Stewards noted the content of the report.

The Raceday Stewards enquired into possible interference in the closing stages involving Falcon Eight, ridden by J. Coen, placed second, Jesse Evans, ridden by R. Whearty, placed fourth, Magellan Strait, ridden by H.J. Horgan, placed first, and My Mate Mozzie, ridden by J.A. Powell, fifth, where it appeared interference may have occurred. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. In his evidence, J. Coen stated that he was going for a gap when it closed. R. Whearty stated that his mount became tired in the last one hundred yards but kept him as straight as he could. H.J. Horgan stated that his mount galloped well to the line and felt he did not cause any interference. J.A. Powell stated that it became a little tight for room and that his mount received a slight bump to his hind quarters. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards made no alteration to the Judge's placings. They were, however, of the opinion that J. Coen was in breach of Rule 214 in that he had ridden carelessly. Having considered his record in this regard, the Raceday Stewards suspended him for four racedays. Mr. M.C. Hickey recused himself from this enquiry.

The Raceday Stewards interviewed D.P. McDonogh, rider of Dawn Rising, concerning his use of the whip in the closing stages of this race of this race. Evidence was heard from the rider concerned who accepted that he was in breach of Regulation 10 and apologised for his actions. Having viewed a recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that D.P. McDonogh was in breach of Regulation 10.3(g)(frequency). Having taken his previous record into account, the Raceday Stewards suspended him for four racedays.

The Raceday Stewards interviewed H.J. Horgan, rider of Magellan Strait, concerning his use of the whip in the closing stages of this race. Evidence was heard from the rider concerned who accepted that he was in breach of Regulation 10. Having viewed a recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that H.J. Horgan was in breach of Regulation 10.3(g)(frequency). Having taken his previous record

into account, the Raceday Stewards suspended H.J. Horgan for four racedays.
