Notice Received From France Galop

ART. 111 - ENTRY FOR FOREIGN-TRAINED HORSES

"In order for a foreign-trained horse to be
entered in a public race in France for the first
time, the horse must be duly declared by the
trainer on the France Galop website **at least 15
days prior to the day of the race** in which the
horse is due to take part. This declaration
must include its full designation including name,
sex, year of foaling, coat, breeding (sire, dam,
dam's sire) and the suffix of the country of birth.
Furthermore, if the race takes place more than
15 days after the entry closing, the declaration
above must be made no later than the day
before the general entry closing day. If an
entry is not registered due to a non-compliance
with this provision, no appeal may be lodged."

Notice To Trainers

Rule 194 (ii)(a)

In the event of an Owner having more than one
declared runner in a race, it shall be the
responsibility of the Trainer to declare to Horse
Racing Ireland, for publication on the race card,
a distinguishing cap for the owner's colours in
respect of any declared horse or horses under
his/her care in that race that is not carrying the
owner's registered colours.

Therefore, please note that in such instances
the declaration of colours must be made to
Horse Racing Ireland via the **Alternate
Colours Facility on RAS or via email to the
Publications Department
publications@hri.ie by 12 noon** on the day
the declarations close unless otherwise stated.

Declaration Of Non-Runners & Reserves

Trainers are requested to note that notifications
of a non-runner or declaration of a reserve **can
now be done via RAS** or on the dedicated
telephone line (045-445645) at the Office of the
I.H.R.B. up to 90 minutes before the time of the
first race.

If using the Non-Runner/Reserve Telephone
Line, the caller will be asked to provide the
Trainer's Horse Racing Ireland account number
and Trainer's date of birth. All calls are recorded
for verification and security purposes.
Veterinary certificates, where required, must be
sent as usual to the Office of the IHRB within 72
hours. A Trainer failing to lodge a certificate
within the time period shall be liable to a fine in
accordance with Rule 194(v)(vi).

Trainers wishing to declare a Reserve a runner
or a non-runner must also do so **via RAS** or on
the same dedicated telephone line number by
**10am for meetings, (other than floodlit
meetings) during the months of November,
December and January** and by 11am for all
other meetings including floodlit meetings
otherwise the reserve will automatically be
withdrawn.

If a rider has not been nominated for a declared
reserve the Trainer must do so by the time fixed
for declaration of a reserve listed within the
paragraph above otherwise the declared
reserve will automatically be withdrawn.

**Declaration of reserves or of non-runners
are no longer accepted at a race meeting.**

Updates can be made **via RÁS anytime after
the publication of Rider Nominations for the
meeting up to the specified deadlines.**

The dedicated line number (045 - 445645) is in
operation from 9am on weekdays when there is
a Race Meeting **and from 8.30am on
weekends and Bank Holidays in November,
December and January.**

Appeals & Referrals

Appeals

The Appeals Body, Ms. Susan Ahern, B.L., (Chair), Mr. Nicholas Wachman and Mr. John Murphy, convened at the Offices of the IHRB on Wednesday 16th August 2023 to consider the appeal of Mr. James Browne, owner of Most Wanted, against the decision of the Raceday Stewards at Killarney on 18th July 2023.

The grounds of appeal lodged by Mr. Browne was that the Raceday Stewards erred in their decision to call the Winner All Right following the running of the William Hill Ireland Maiden as it was his belief that interference had been caused.

At the Appeal Hearing, evidence was heard from Mr. Ben Browne, on behalf of Mr. James Browne.

In his evidence Mr. Browne explained that the owner had been unable to lodge an objection prior to the Winner All Right being called on the day, due to not having had access to all camera footage and not having been in attendance on the day to see the race. Mr. Browne stated his belief that Most Wanted had been struck by the whip of Leigh Roche, rider of Coolree, which cost Most Wanted significant ground and momentum and ultimately cost Most Wanted the race and that as such the Winner All Right should not have been called.

Having considered the evidence, Ms. Ahern read out the following decision on behalf of the Appeals Body.

"This matter has come as an appeal of The Winner All Right being called by the Raceday Stewards following the William Hill Ireland Maiden on 18th July 2023 in Killarney. As a preliminary matter, an issue was raised by the IHRB and supported by the notice party that the scope of the Appeals Body was limited to consideration of the Winner All Right decision and could not go further. The view of the appellant was that the Rules did not limit the scope of the Appeal. The Appeal Body considered the rules and in relation to Rule 262(iv), an objection to the Raceday Stewards is subject to time limits. However, in special circumstances where the Raceday Stewards are satisfied it could not have been made within in this time an exception can be made. The Appeals Body considers that there are special circumstances here in light of the following facts:

1) Mr. Browne was not aware of the incident until his further studies of the race.

2) In circumstances where neither the jockey or the trainer reported under Rule 213(ii) and/or Rule 213(iii) any matter which had or could have had a bearing on the running of the horse.

3) The notification of the objection was submitted to the IHRB within 48 hours which the Panel considers to be within the bounds of Rule 213(iii) which requires such objections to be made as soon as possible.

In accordance with Rule 19.C.4(i), the Appeals Body has the power to determine an appeal against the Raceday Stewards. In exercising this power, we consider that the matter is:

1) The Raceday Stewards decision to call the Winner All Right, was made in the absence of any objection or report.

2) The Owner, Mr. Browne, was not in a position to object until his review of the race and did so within 48 hours. Therefore, the Raceday Stewards made their decision at the time of the race in the absence of information which has now become available.

Having considered all of these points, the Appeals Body notes that we have the authority under Rule 19.C.4(i) to hear appeals against decisions of the Raceday Stewards. The decision of the Raceday Stewards was made in the absence of information, therefore the Appeal Body determines the following:

- 1) Under Rule 256 the panel has the jurisdiction to make this decision.
- 2) The appeal has merit on the basis of the special circumstances under Rule 262(iv) and therefore the Raceday Stewards decision to declare the Winner All Right is therefore reversed.
- 3) The appropriate next step is to remit consideration of the Winner All Right decision to a Referrals Committee to consider the race.
- 4) Mr. Browne's appeal deposit should be refunded.

The appeal was presented by Mr. Ben Browne, on behalf of Mr. James Browne. Mr. Jennifer Lynch, owner of Coolree was represented by Mr. Patrick Kennedy, solicitor, of Patrick J. O'Meara Solicitors, Thurles, County Tipperary. The IHRB was represented by Ms. Clíodhna Guy, IHRB Head of Licensing, Legal and Compliance

This declaration is not considered as an entry. Trainers are to make their entries and other declarations directly online. They must also supply a complete race record of all the performances of the horse(s) entered on the Internet, by fax (33 1 47 61 93 37) or email (fgperf@france-galop.com). The entry will not be valid if these performances are not received by the international department at Racing Operations by the time of the first forfeit, or on the eve of the declaration to run (if entries were made more than a month before the race). When declaring a horse to run, it is the responsibility of the trainer to check the weight carried.

Italy - Owners and trainers of horses trained outside Italy are informed that, the first time they enter any horse to run in Italy, they must include with the entry the correct name, sex, year of foaling, pedigree (sire, dam and sire of dam) and the name of the country where the horse was foaled.

IRISH RACE PROGRAMME - STANDARD CONDITIONS

Horses and those in charge of them are received on the terms that the Executive and the Stewards of the respective Meetings are not to be liable for any damage, loss or injury to such horses or persons while in or about the stabling or on the Course from any cause whatsoever.

Nominations can only be made and accepted on the condition that the nominator subjects himself/herself, in all respects to the Rules & HRI Directives under which each race is run. Races and divisions are run subject to the provisions of Rule 20.

Handicap races closing under the Irish entry system will be calculated at the time of closing. The rating qualification will take into account all performances up to and including the **Sunday** previous to the rating qualification date.

In accordance with Rule 101 (iv), the Qualifying Ratings shall be calculated on each Monday at 12 noon. The Qualifying Rating for each horse shall be equivalent to the horse's current Rating at that time.

Qualifying Ratings For Flat Races

For the purposes of qualification for flat handicaps, in the event of a horse being assigned a separate handicap mark for "all weather" handicaps, the "all weather" qualification rating will be the horse's qualifying rating for "all weather" racing. In the event of a horse being assigned only one handicap rating, the same qualifying rating shall apply for qualification purposes to handicaps run on both turf and "all weather" surfaces.

Entries & Declarations

Entries for horses trained outside of Ireland must be made through the relevant Turf Authority and close by 11am on the same day they close with Horse Racing Ireland. Entries for early closing races are accepted through the relevant Turf Authorities on the same day they close with Horse Racing Ireland at 12 noon.

All trainers licenced in Ireland can only make entries by the following methods: a) Online RAS System b) Fax (045 455423) c) Email - entries@hri.ie.

All trainers licenced in Ireland can only make declarations by the following methods: a) Online RAS System b) Telephone (045 455422).

For the purpose of the 2023/2024 National Hunt season:-

'Novice' for hurdle races is a horse which has not won a hurdle race prior to 30th April, 2023 and for steeplechases is a horse which has not won a steeplechase prior to 30th April, 2023 other than one hunter steeplechase within the previous two National Hunt seasons. However, any horse which wins a hurdle race for the first time or a steeplechase (hunter steeplechase excluded) for the first time between 1st February, 2023 and 29th April, 2023 will be qualified as a 'Novice' for the period up to and including 3rd December, 2023 other than the winner of a Grade 1 Weight For Age Hurdle or Steeplechase prior to 30th April, 2023.

Overnight Nomination Of Rider & Colours

Under Rule 195, it is compulsory to nominate a rider for each declared horse by 12 noon on the day that Declarations close. Under Rule 155 the trainer must declare any intended change of colours or any colours in use that are not registered with Horse Racing Ireland for racecard purposes. In such instances the declaration of colours must be made to Horse Racing Ireland by 12 noon on the day the declarations close unless otherwise stated.
