Notice Received From France Galop

ART. 111 - ENTRY FOR FOREIGN-TRAINED HORSES

"In order for a foreign-trained horse to be entered in a public race in France for the first time, the horse must be duly declared by the trainer on the France Galop website at least 15 days prior to the day of the race in which the horse is due to take part. This declaration must include its full designation including name, sex, year of foaling, coat, breeding (sire, dam, dam's sire) and the suffix of the country of birth. Furthermore, if the race takes place more than 15 days after the entry closing, the declaration above must be made no later than the day before the general entry closing day. entry is not registered due to a non-compliance with this provision, no appeal may be lodged."

Irish Horseracing Regulatory Board Notice

Declaration Of Non-Runners & Reserves

Trainers are requested to note that notifications of a non-runner or declaration of a reserve can now be done via RAS or on the dedicated telephone line (045-445645) at the Office of the I.H.R.B. up to 90 minutes before the time of the first race

If using the Non-Runner/Reserve Telephone Line, the caller will be asked to provide the Trainer's Horse Racing Ireland account number and Trainer's date of birth. All calls are recorded for verification and security purposes. Veterinary certificates, where required, must be sent as usual to the Office of the IHRB within 72 hours. A Trainer failing to lodge a certificate within the time period shall be liable to a fine in accordance with Rule 194(v)(vi).

Trainers wishing to declare a Reserve a runner or a non-runner must also do so via RAS or on the same dedicated telephone line number by 10am for meetings, (other than floodlit meetings) during the months of November, December and January and by 11am for all other meetings including floodlit meetings otherwise the reserve will automatically be withdrawn.

If a rider has not been nominated for a declared reserve the Trainer must do so by the time fixed for declaration of a reserve listed within the paragraph above otherwise the declared reserve will automatically be withdrawn.

Declaration of reserves or of non-runners are no longer accepted at a race meeting.

Updates can be made via RAS anytime after the publication of Rider Nominations for the meeting up to the specified deadlines.

The dedicated line number (045 - 445645) is in operation from 9am on weekdays when there is a Race Meeting and from 8.30am on weekends and Bank Holidays in November, December and January.

Appeals & Referrals

Appeals

The Appeals Body, Mr N.B. Wachman (Chairman), Mr Anthony Byrne and Mr M.C. Hickey convened at the Offices of the Irish Horseracing Regulatory Board on Tuesday, 26 March 2024 to consider the appeal of Gavin Ryan (Rider) following the decision of the Raceday Stewards at Dundalk on Friday, 15 March 2023.

Following the running of the 361 Days To The Supreme BetVictor Handicap, the Raceday Stewards found Mr Ryan, rider of Arnhem, in breach of Rule 214 in that he had ridden carelessly and having considered his record in this regard they suspended him for one raceday.

The grounds of appeal lodged by Mr Ryan was that the Stewards on the day erred in their decision.

At the Appeal Hearing, evidence was heard from Mr Ryan and the Appeals Body also watched a recording of the race.

In his evidence, Mr Ryan explained that he maintained his racing line and if there was any interference, it wasn't caused by him as in his opinion he was clear of the horses behind him.

Having considered the evidence, the Appeals Body allowed the appeal. The appeal was presented by Mr Ryan. The IHRB was represented by Ms Clíodhna Guy, Head of Licensing, Legal and Compliance and Mr Andrew Ring, IHRB Stipendiary Steward.
