Rule 194 (ii)(a)

In the event of an Owner having more than one declared runner in a race, it shall be the responsibility of the Trainer to declare to Horse Racing Ireland, for publication on the race card, a distinguishing cap for the owner's colours in respect of any declared horse or horses under his/her care in that race that is not carrying the owner's registered colours.

Therefore, please note that in such instances the declaration of colours must be made to Horse Racing Ireland via the **Alternate Colours Facility on RAS or via email to the Publications Department publications@hri.ie by 12 noon** on the day the declarations close unless otherwise stated.

Owners and Handlers of horses who wish to run at Westmeath (F) on Sunday 1st October should ensure that Hunters Certificates are lodged at the Offices of the IHRB, The Curragh, Co. Kildare, R56 Y668 for registration **no later than close of business on Monday 11th September.**

Owners and Handlers of horses who wish to run at Mid Antrim (H) on Saturday 7th October and Galway Blazers (F) on Sunday 8th October should ensure that Hunters Certificates are lodged at the Offices of the IHRB, The Curragh, Co. Kildare, R56 Y668 for registration **no later than close of business on Monday 18th September.**

Please note the registration fee for a Hunters Certificate is now €100 (which includes a temporary insurance levy of €35).

Point To Point Regulation Changes

The Stewards of the Irish National Hunt Steeplechase Committee and Directors of the Irish Horseracing Regulatory Board using their powers under Rule 22 have modified Regulations 1(i), 4(ii), 6(v), 8 (vi), 12, 19(i), 20(ii), 22(v), 23(a)(iii) & (vii), 23(b)(vi) & (xii), 24(ii)(a)(iii), 50, 58 3 (h) & (i), 6. ION 4, deleted Regulation 59 and introduced Rules 85 and 271 to the Irish National Hunt Steeplechase Regulations for Point to Point Steeplechases to read as follows:

The modifications are underlined and will come into effect on 21st September 2023.

Definitions

- 1.(i) "Chief Medical Officer", or a designated Deputy, is the person appointed by the Directors of the IHRB to be responsible for the overall medical supervision of all riders with particular emphasis on their fitness to ride and the co-ordination of the medical provision to riders on Raceday. There is further responsibility for the provision of advice on medical matters to the IHRB. The Chief Medical Officer will also carry out any other duties as defined from time to time by the Directors of the IHRB. The Chief Medical Officer shall have all the powers as outlined for the IHRB Medical Officer.
 - 4.(ii) Application for Point to Point Meetings, giving a first and second choice of dates, accompanied by a fee of €65 must be made by the Master of the Hunt (or in the absence of a Master, a Committee appointed by the Hunt) to the Office of the I.N.H.S. Committee. **[Text Deleted]**
 - 6.(v) A Hunters Certificate shall not be registered or remain registered for any Horse which is the subject of a non-racing declaration in accordance with HRI Directive 16. 3.
 - 8.(vi) The maximum number of runners for all point to point steeplechases shall be:
- "Chief Veterinary Officer" or "CVO" means the senior Official of the IHRB appointed by the Directors

of the IHRB as Chief Veterinary Officer or their designated deputy.

"IHRB Medical Officer" means a qualified doctor appointed under Rule 28 or any appropriately qualified substitute appointed under Rule 29 in accordance with Regulation 3(c) of the Constitution of the IHRB.

"Missed Test" means a Horse's unavailability for examination or test pursuant to Rule 20(xvii) or Regulation R14.

"Office of the IHRB" is currently at the Curragh, County Kildare, R56 Y668.

"Sampling Officer" means a person appointed by the Doping Control Officer, pursuant to Rule 20 (xx), to take samples for the purposes of Dope Tests.

"Senior Racing Official" is a person appointed or retained by the IHRB in accordance with Regulation 3(c) of the Constitution of the IHRB and to whom certain functions have been delegated by the IHRB.

"Turf Authorities of Ireland" shall mean the IHRB and, for the purposes of carrying out its functions under relevant legislation, HRI.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

The Racing Calendar Office of Weatherbys Thoroughbred Ltd. receives entries submitted for acceptance as agents for the Racecourse Authority and only upon the terms of the Standard Conditions. Acceptance of entries is subject to the power to refuse to allow entries to be accepted conferred by the Orders and Rules of Racing on the British Horseracing Authority Ltd. Entries are accepted by the Racing Calendar Office, acting as aforesaid, causing the name of the horse in question to be published as being entered for the race in question either in The Racing Calendar, when the race closes more than six days before running, or, for other races, on the British Horseracing Authority Racing Administration Internet site (www.racingadmin.co.uk) and ordinarily in the Sporting Press.

FRANCE - Owners and trainers of horses trained outside of France are reminded that, to enter any horse in a French race for the first time, they must register their horses in training through their access online at least 8 days before the closing time of entry, with the correct name of the horse, its suffix, sex, year of foaling and pedigree (sire, dam and sire of dam).

This declaration is not considered as an entry. Trainers are to make their entries and other declarations directly online. They must also supply a complete race record of all the performances of the horse(s) entered on the Internet, by fax (33 1 47 61 93 37) or email (fgperf@france-galop.com). The entry will not be valid if these performances are not received by the international department at Racing Operations by the time of the first forfeit, or on the eve of the declaration to run (if entries were made more than a month before the race). When declaring a horse to run, it is the responsibility of the trainer to check the weight carried.

Italy - Owners and trainers of horses trained outside Italy are informed that, the first time they enter any horse to run in Italy, they must include with the entry the correct name, sex, year of foaling, pedigree (sire, dam and sire of dam) and the name of the country where the horse was foaled.

IRISH RACE PROGRAMME - STANDARD CONDITIONS

Horses and those in charge of them are received on the terms that the Executive and the Stewards of the respective Meetings are not to be liable for any damage, loss or injury to such horses or persons while in or about the stabling or on the Course from any cause whatsoever.

Nominations can only be made and accepted on the condition that the nominator subjects himself/herself, in all respects to the Rules & HRI Directives under which each race is run. Races and divisions are run subject to the provisions of Rule 20.

Handicap races closing under the Irish entry system will be calculated at the time of closing. The rating qualification will take into account all performances up to and including the **Sunday** previous to the rating qualification date.

In accordance with Rule 101 (iv), the Qualifying Ratings shall be calculated on each Monday at 12 noon. The Qualifying Rating for each horse shall be equivalent to the horse's current Rating at that time.

Qualifying Ratings For Flat Races

For the purposes of qualification for flat handicaps, in the event of a horse being assigned a separate handicap mark for "all weather" handicaps, the "all weather" qualification rating will be the horse's qualifying rating for "all weather" racing. In the event of a horse being assigned only one handicap rating, the same qualifying rating shall apply for qualification purposes to handicaps run on both turf and "all weather" surfaces.

Entries & Declarations

Entries for horses trained outside of Ireland must be made through the relevant Turf Authority and close by 11am on the same day they close with Horse Racing Ireland. Entries for early closing races are accepted through the relevant Turf Authorities on the same day they close with Horse Racing Ireland at 12 noon.

All trainers licenced in Ireland can only make entries by the following methods: a) Online RAS System b) Fax (045 455423) c) Email - entries@hri.ie.

All trainers licenced in Ireland can only make declarations by the following methods: a) Online RAS System b) Telephone (045 455422).

For the purpose of the 2023/2024 National Hunt season:-

'Novice' for hurdle races is a horse which has not won a hurdle race prior to 30th April, 2023 and for steeplechases is a horse which has not won a steeplechase prior to 30th April, 2023 other than one hunter steeplechase within the previous two National Hunt seasons.
