Notice To Trainers Rule 194 (ii)(a)

In the event of an Owner having more than one declared runner in a race, it shall be the responsibility of the Trainer to declare to Horse Racing Ireland, for publication on the race card, a distinguishing cap for the owner's colours in respect of any declared horse or horses under his/her care in that race that is not carrying the owner's registered colours.

Therefore, please note that in such instances the declaration of colours must be made to Horse Racing Ireland via the Alternate Colours Facility on RAS or via email to the Publications Department publications@hri.ie by 12 noon on the day the declarations close unless otherwise stated.

Important Notice - Hunters Certificates

Owners and Handlers of horses who wish to run at Westmeath (F) on Sunday 1st October should ensure that Hunters Certificates are lodged at the Offices of the IHRB, The Curragh, Co. Kildare, R56 Y668 for registration no later than close of business on Monday 11th September.

Owners and Handlers of horses who wish to run at Mid Antrim (H) on Saturday 7th October and Galway Blazers (F) on Sunday 8th October should ensure that Hunters Certificates are lodged at the Offices of the IHRB, The Curragh, Co. Kildare, R56 Y668 for registration no later than close of business on Monday 18th September.

Please note the registration fee for a Hunters Certificate is now $\in 100$ (which includes a temporary insurance levy of $\in 35$).

Point To Point Regulation Changes

The Stewards of the Irish National Hunt Steeplechase Committee and Directors of the Irish Horseracing Regulatory Board using their powers under Rule 22 have modified Regulations 1(i), 4(ii), 6(v), 8 (vi), 12, 19(i), 20(ii), 22(v), 23(a)(iii) & (vii), 23(b)(vi) & (xii), 24(ii)(a)(iii), 50, 58 3 (h) & (i), 6. ION 4, deleted Regulation 59 and introduced Rules 85 and 271 to the Irish National Hunt Steeplechases Regulations for Point to Point Steeplechases to read as follows:

The modifications are underlined and will come into effect on 21st September 2023.

Definitions

1.(i)

"Chief Medical Officer", or a designated Deputy, is the person appointed by the Directors of the IHRB to be responsible for the overall medical supervision of all riders with particular emphasis on their fitness to ride and the co-ordination of the medical provision to riders on Raceday. There is further responsibility for the provision of advice medical matters to IHRB. The Chief Medical Officer will also carry out any other duties as defined from time to time by the Directors of the IHRB. The Chief Medical Officer shall have all the powers as outlined for the IHRB Medical Officer.

"Chief Veterinary Officer"
or "CVO" means the senior
Official of the IHRB

"IHRB Medical Officer"
means a qualified doctor

Rule 29 in accordance with
Regulation 3(c) of the
Constitution of the IHRB.

"Missed Test" means a Horse's unavailability for examination or test pursuant to Rule 20(xvii) or Regulation R14.

"Office of the IHRB" is currently at the Curragh, County Kildare, R56 Y668.

"Sampling Officer" means a person appointed by the Doping Control Officer, pursuant to Rule 20 (xx), to take samples for the purposes of Dope Tests.

"Senior Racing Official" is a person appointed or retained by the IHRB in accordance with Regulation 3(c) of the Constitution of the IHRB and to whom certain functions have been delegated by the IHRB.

"Turf Authorities of Ireland" shall mean the IHRB and, for the purposes of carrying out its functions under relevant legislation, HRI.

Application for Point to Point Meetings, giving a first and second choice of dates, accompanied by a fee of €65 must be made by the Master of the Hunt (or in the absence of a Master, a Committee appointed by the Hunt) to the Office of the I.N.H.S. Committee. [Text Deleted]

A Hunters Certificate shall not be registered or remain registered for any Horse which is the subject of a non-racing declaration in accordance with HRI Directive 16. 3.

8.(vi) The maximum number of runners for all point to point steeplechases shall be:

- (a) Not more than fifteen horses in races confined to four year olds only.
- (b) Not more than fifteen horses in races confined to Novice Riders only.
- (c) Not more than seventeen horses in all other races.

If upon inspection there is a need to reduce the maximum number of runners, the Inspector of Courses shall state the revised number in his report. Such figure shall be the maximum number permitted to run on the day and it shall be publicly announced before the commencement of the first race.

The total amount of added money given for a full programme shall not be less than €6,500 and the prize money to the first, second and third horses, [Text Deleted] shall not be less than €800 in races confined to horses aged 4yo or 5yo and €1750 in all other races. [Text Deleted] In the case of a race or races being divided the added money may however be increased to such an amount as is necessary to enable each division of a race to have the original full prize fund for that race allocated to the division.

In all races the Owners of the first three placed horses shall receive 70%, 20% and 10% respectively, of the total value of the race.

Entries for races shall be made by the Owner or Handler and shall be subject to the Regulations for Point to Point Steeplechases.

Arrange for the attendance of two registered road ambulances and registered four wheel drive ambulance which comes equipped with a stretcher. They shall also arrange for a Hunt Medical Officer to be in attendance and for a suitable facility for the medical examination of injured riders. A second Medical Officer appointed by the IHRB shall be in attendance.

The Acting Stewards have power to <u>sanction</u> at their discretion any rider subject to their control with a fine not exceeding €500 and/or with the suspension from riding for any period up to

seven Point to Point racedays beginning no earlier than the fourteenth day after their decision and if they deem necessary, to refer the rider to the R.A.C.E. or to report the matter to the Referrals Committee, for any breach of these Regulations or any Orders or Instructions made or issued under these Regulations, save that

- (a) if a rider on the commencement date already be suspended for any other offence, the suspension shall at the beain commencement of the day following the completion of anv previous period suspension.
- (b) if a rider elects to serve a suspension of one day commencing earlier than the fourteenth day upon agreement with the IHRB.

Riders will not be permitted to ride under any Rules of Racing or Steeplechasing on suspended days.

An IHRB Medical Officer or

The minimum standard which Body Protectors must meet is EN13158:2018 Level (Racesafe modified version as approved in 2023) or such other standard as approved by the IHRB. There must not be an attachment between the Body Protector and the saddle or girths. [Text Deleted] Body Protectors must be worn with a harness (crotch strap) by riders when weighing out, weighing in and during a race. Body Protectors must not be modified in any way and must be in a serviceable condition. An IHRB Medical Officer or the Chief Medical Officer may

direct that a Body Protector be replaced post inspection.

Offending riders shall be liable to sanction in accordance with Regulation 22 (v).

24.(ii)(a)(iii)

A declaration shall not be accepted for a horse unless a Vaccination Certificate against Equine Influenza in accordance with the provisions of Rule 91 has been approved by the IHRB by 12 noon on the day following the closing of entries. However, should a Point to Point Meeting be rescheduled with original

The decision of the Acting Stewards may be the subject of an appeal to the Appeals Body by the Owner, Handler or rider of any horse running in the race. In all cases, except where fraud or wilful misstatement is alleged, notice of appeal, signed by the appellant, accompanied by a deposit of €500 and giving specific reasons for the appeal, must be given to The Registrar of the I.N.H.S. Committee within 48 hours of the decision being made known, or the appellant shall forfeit their right to appeal. [Text Deleted] If the appeal be decided against depositor, their deposit shall be forfeited unless the Appeals Body consider that there were good and reasonable grounds appeal.

The Racing Calendar Office of Weatherbys Thoroughbred Ltd. receives entries submitted for acceptance as agents for the Racecourse Authority and only upon the terms of the Standard Conditions. Acceptance of entries is subject to the power to refuse to allow entries to be accepted conferred by the Orders and Rules of Racing on the British Horseracing Authority Ltd. This declaration is not considered as an entry. Trainers are to make their entries and other declarations directly online. They must also supply a complete race record of all the performances of the horse(s) entered on the Internet, by fax (33 1 47 61 93 37) or email (fgperf@france-galop.com). The entry will not be valid if these performances are not received by the international department at Racing Operations by the time of the first forfeit, or on the eve of the declaration to run (if entries were made more than a month before the race).

When declaring a horse to run, it is the responsibility of the trainer to check the weight carried.

Italy - Owners and trainers of horses trained outside Italy are informed that, the first time they enter any horse to run in Italy, they must include with the entry the correct name, sex, year of foaling, pedigree (sire, dam and sire of dam) and the name of the country where the horse was foaled.

IRISH RACE PROGRAMME - STANDARD CONDITIONS

Horses and those in charge of them are received on the terms that the Executive and the Stewards of the respective Meetings are not to be liable for any damage, loss or injury to such horses or persons while in or about the stabling or on the Course from any cause whatsoever.

Nominations can only be made and accepted on the condition that the nominator subjects himself/herself, in all respects to the Rules & HRI Directives under which each race is run.

Races and divisions are run subject to the provisions of Rule 20.

Handicap races closing under the Irish entry system will be calculated at the time of closing.

The rating qualification will take into account all performances up to and including the **Sunday** previous to the rating qualification date.

In accordance with Rule 101 (iv), the Qualifying Ratings shall be calculated on each Monday at 12 noon. The Qualifying Rating for each horse shall be equivalent to the horse's current Rating at that time.

Qualifying Ratings For Flat Races

For the purposes of qualification for flat handicaps, in the event of a horse being assigned a separate handicap mark for "all weather" handicaps, the "all weather" qualification rating will be the horse's qualifying rating for "all weather" racing. In the event of a horse being assigned only one handicap rating, the same qualifying rating shall apply for qualification purposes to handicaps run on both turf and "all weather" surfaces.

Entries & Declarations

Entries for horses trained outside of Ireland must be made through the relevant Turf Authority and close by 11am on the same day they close with Horse Racing Ireland. Entries for early closing races are accepted through the relevant Turf Authorities on the same day they close with Horse Racing Ireland at 12 noon.

All trainers licenced in Ireland can only make entries by the following methods: a) Online RAS System b) Fax (045 455423) c) Email -entries@hri.ie.

All trainers licenced in Ireland can only make declarations by the following methods: a) Online RAS System b)Telephone (045 455422).

For the purpose of the 2023/2024 National Hunt season:-

'Novice' for hurdle races is a horse which has not won a hurdle race prior to 30th April, 2023 and for steeplechases is a horse which has not won a steeplechase prior to 30th April, 2023 other than one hunter steeplechase within the previous two National Hunt seasons. However, any horse which wins a hurdle race for the first time or a steeplechase (hunter steeplechase excluded) for the first time between 1st February, 2023 and 29th April, 2023 will be qualified as a 'Novice' for the period up to and including 3rd December, 2023 other than the winner of a Grade 1 Weight For Age Hurdle or Steeplechase prior to 30th April, 2023.

Overnight Nomination Of Rider & Colours

Under Rule 195, it is compulsory to nominate a rider for each declared horse by 12 noon on the day that Declarations close. Under Rule 155 the trainer must declare any intended change of colours or any colours in use that are not registered with Horse Racing Ireland for racecard purposes. In such instances the declaration of colours must be made to Horse Racing Ireland by 12 noon on the day the declarations close unless otherwise stated.
