### Irish Horseracing Regulatory Board Notice

#### **Declaration Of Non-Runners & Reserves**

Trainers are requested to note that notifications of a non-runner or declaration of a reserve **can now be done via RAS** or on the dedicated telephone line (045-445645) at the Office of the I.H.R.B. up to 90 minutes before the time of the first race

If using the Non-Runner/Reserve Telephone Line, the caller will be asked to provide the Trainer's Horse Racing Ireland account number and Trainer's date of birth. All calls are recorded for verification and security purposes. Veterinary certificates, where required, must be sent as usual to the Office of the IHRB within 72 hours. A Trainer failing to lodge a certificate within the time period shall be liable to a fine in accordance with Rule 194(v)(vi).

Trainers wishing to declare a Reserve a runner or a non-runner must also do so via RAS or on the same dedicated telephone line number by 10am for meetings, (other than floodlit meetings) during the months of November, December and January and by 11am for all other meetings including floodlit meetings otherwise the reserve will automatically be withdrawn.

If a rider has not been nominated for a declared reserve the Trainer must do so by the time fixed for declaration of a reserve listed within the paragraph above otherwise the declared reserve will automatically be withdrawn.

Declaration of reserves or of non-runners are no longer accepted at a race meeting.

Updates can be made via RAS anytime after the publication of Rider Nominations for the meeting up to the specified deadlines.

The dedicated line number (045 - 445645) is in operation from 9am on weekdays when there is a Race Meeting and from 8.30am on weekends and Bank Holidays in November, December and January.

#### **Horse Racing Ireland Directives:**

The Directors of Horse Racing Ireland have approved the following modifications to HRI Directives 8 & 13 to come into effect on Monday 16th June 2025.

#### **HRI DIRECTIVE 8**

#### The Forfeit List:

a. The Forfeit List shall be kept at HRI and shall be published at least twice annually in the Irish Racing Calendar. It shall include all arrears which have been notified by the Stakeholder of any recognised meeting in Ireland, or as otherwise provided under the Rules of Racing/IHRB or any amount otherwise due to HRI or unpaid Foal

Levy due to HRI as advised by Weatherbys Ireland, and shall state the name or names of the persons or Companies from whom the horses in respect of which the same are due. "Arrears" or "amounts due" which have been so published must either be paid direct to HRI or notification that they have been duly paid must be received by HRI from some recognised Turf Authority or Weatherbys Ireland and, until so paid or until such notification has been received, such persons or Companies shall not be removed from the Forfeit List.

#### **HRI DIRECTIVE 13**

#### Terms of Business - Horse Racing Clients:

#### 2. Client Payments

HRI will accept instructions to pay funds out of a client's account by telephone, fax or letter, email or via the client online system. Payments will be made directly to the client's bank account by electronic funds transfer (EFT) normally within two The bank details working days. section on the owner registration form must be completed at account set-up. A copy of the "Header" part of the client bank statement must also be submitted to verify the bank details. This "Header" must be dated within six three months of the date of account set-up and show the name, address, bank account name, IBAN and BIC number of the client which should correspond with that of the HRI account holder. In the event of a cheque being issued it will only be in the name of the client and will be marked account payee only. Cheques are issued monthly.

#### 3. Fees and Charges

d. In the event that there are any amounts due to HRI, including, for the avoidance of doubt, any outstanding foal levy due to HRI, that unpaid <a href="mailto:such">such</a> amounts may be deducted from client funds (upon notification from Weatherbys), whether such client funds represent funds credited to the account by client deposits or prize monies where such amounts due to HRI remain outstanding.

#### STANDARD CONDITIONS

The Racing Calendar Office of Weatherbys Thoroughbred Ltd. receives entries submitted for acceptance as agents for the Racecourse Authority and only upon the terms of the Standard Conditions. Acceptance of entries is subject to the power to refuse to allow entries to be accepted conferred by the Orders and Rules of Racing on the British Horseracing Authority Ltd. Entries are accepted by the Racing Calendar Office, acting as aforesaid, causing the name of the horse in question to be published as being entered for the race in question either in The Racing Calendar, when the race closes more than six days before running, or, for other races, on the British Horseracing Authority Racing Administration Internet site (www.racingadmin.co.uk) and ordinarily in the Sporting Press.

**FRANCE** - Owners and trainers of horses trained outside of France are reminded that, to enter any horse in a French race for the first time, they must register their horses in training through their access online at least 8 days before the closing time of entry, with the correct name of the horse, its suffix, sex, year of foaling and pedigree (sire, dam and sire of dam).

This declaration is not considered as an entry. Trainers are to make their entries and other declarations directly online. They must also supply a complete race record of all the performances of the horse(s) entered on the Internet, by fax (33 1 47 61 93 37) or email (fgperf@france-galop.com). The entry will not be valid if these performances are not received by the international department at Racing Operations by the time of the first forfeit, or on the eve of the declaration to run (if entries were made more than a month before the race).

When declaring a horse to run, it is the responsibility of the trainer to check the weight carried.

Italy - Owners and trainers of horses trained outside Italy are informed that, the first time they enter any horse to run in Italy, they must include with the entry the correct name, sex, year of foaling, pedigree (sire, dam and sire of dam) and the name of the country where the horse was foaled.

- **155D Ladbrokes 'We're Big On Boosts' M'dn H'dle** J.I. Duggan, rider of Buttermere Ridge, trained by Oliver McKiernan, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his saddle slipped after the second hurdle.
- **155F(i)** Ladbrokes 'Gaffer Of All Accas' H'cap H'dle (Division One) P. Hanlon, rider of Bob The Builder, trained by R.P. Rath, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount stopped quickly.
- G. Brouder, rider of Ixigreczed (FR), trained by E. Seymour, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount was badly hampered by a faller in the backstraight.

The Raceday Stewards reviewed an incident passing the stands on the first circuit involving Oogum Boogum, ridden by C.P. Millar, where it appeared Oogum Boogum made slight contact with the rail. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the matter, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that no further action was warranted.

The Raceday Stewards interviewed L. Quinlan, rider of Kalnoo, concerning his use of the whip in in the closing stages of this race. Evidence was heard from the rider concerned who accepted he was in breach of the whip Regulation and apologised for his actions. Having viewed a recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that L. Quinlan was in breach of R.10.3(g)(frequency). Having considered his record in this regard (second offence), they suspended him for four racedays.

- **155F(ii)** Ladbrokes 'Gaffer Of All Accas' H'cap H'dle (Division Two) E. Walsh, rider of Coole Cottage, trained by David Kenneth Budds, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount stopped quickly and pulled up.
- 155G Allied Recycling (Pro-Am) INH Flat Race The Raceday Stewards informed Anthony Mullins, trainer of Muted Melody, that a repeat performance in the behaviour of his charge, who was withdrawn by order of the Raceday Stewards having refused to go to the start, may render the animal liable to suspension in the future.

Miss G. Benson, rider of Morning Mayhem (GB), trained by Peter John Flood, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that her mount hung badly left for the last four furlongs.

- P. Cleary replaced J. Coen on Howdoyalikeherhome, trained by Gordon Elliott (Race 6) (Injured)
- **156C K-Mech Mechanical H'cap S'chase** The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Lisnagar Fortune, trained by W.P. Mullins, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be blowing hard post race.

The Raceday Stewards requested a report from T.M. Walsh, trainer, as to the apparent improvement in form of Hardwired, placed first, as compared with his recent form. T.M. Walsh stated that a drop back in trip on a track where he has won twice before coupled with everything falling right for him today had helped to bring about the apparent improvement in form. Having considered the report, the Raceday Stewards noted the explanation given.

- K.C. Sexton, rider of Antrim Coast, trained by Gavin Cromwell, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount suffered interference on the bend from the winner. Having viewed a recording of the race and considered the matter, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that no further action was warranted.
- 156E Lily & Wild (Mares) M'dn H'dle The Raceday Stewards received a request from Eoin Griffin, trainer of Doyentohurl, to allow his charge to run without hind shoes as she had pulled one shoe in transit and he wanted to remove the other one also. He added that his charge requires sedation to be shod. Having considered the matter, the Raceday Stewards, pursuant to the provisions of Regulation 16, allowed Doyentohurl to run without hind shoes on this occasion.
- 156F John Dowling Memorial M'dn H'dle The Raceday Stewards enquired into an incident approximately four and a half furlongs from home involving Jetovango, ridden by E. Walsh, unplaced, Mister Frostie, ridden by J.P. O'Sullivan, unplaced, Stickman, ridden by A. McCurtin, unplaced, and Tippawan Haa, ridden by J. Smith, placed sixth, where it appeared Jetovango clipped a heel. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. E. Walsh stated that his race was run, was unable to hold his position

and was retreating when things became tight. J.P. O'Sullivan stated that it was general bunching as horses leaned in on the bend. A. McCurtin stated that he maintained his line. J. Smith stated that his mount was very green but that the two horses on the outside maintained their line. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards took no further action other than to remind J.P. O'Sullivan to be more mindful of horses on his inner dropping away.

G.B. Noonan, rider of Tinking Man, trained by Eoin Christopher McCarthy, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount hung badly left.

156G Madison Flooring Supporting H'cap H'dle The Raceday Stewards enquired into possible interference at the last hurdle and to the line involving Londonofficecallin, ridden by K.E. Buckley, placed first and Stay Gold, ridden by L.A. McKenna, placed second, where it appeared that interference may have occurred. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. K.E. Buckley stated that both horses jumped the last hurdle to their left independently of each other and that the second horse had not suffered any interference at it. Furthermore, he added that when they made contact it was after the finish line. L.A. McKenna stated that he was badly hampered at the last and then closed all the way to the line. Furthermore, he added that he felt it had cost him the race. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that Londonofficecallin was sufficiently clear when jumping left at the last and that Stay Gold had drifted left towards the stands on the run to the line of its own accord. Furthermore, they were satisfied that the bump between the two was after the line so they made no alteration to the Judge's placings and took no further action.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer reported to the Raceday Stewards that Coral River, trained by Thomas Mullins, was found to be lame on his right hind post race.

The Raceday Stewards enquired from B.W. Harvey, rider of Navigator Jack, who slipped up on the home bend. B.W. Harvey stated that his mount slipped up independently of any other horse. Having considered the matter and viewed a recording of the race, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that no further action was warranted.

156H Irish European Breeders Fund (Mares) (Pro-Am) INH Flat Race The Raceday Stewards, prior to racing, granted a request from the IHRB Clerk Of The Course to amend the distance of this race to two miles and ninety yards, due to necessary rail realignment.

The Raceday Stewards granted permission for Ode To Joy to run in accordance with the provision of Rule 90(v) as positive identification can be made but there are discrepancies in the markings as recorded in the Passport. The Trainer shall have (30) days to update the passport to the satisfaction of an IHRB Veterinary Officer/Assistant.

The Raceday Stewards interviewed Mr P.W. Mullins, rider of Brosna Queen, concerning his use of the whip in the closing stages of this race. Evidence was heard from the rider concerned who stated that his first strike was waving and did not connect. Having viewed a recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards gave Mr. Mullins the benefit of the doubt on this occasion and took no further action.

156J Bermingham Cameras M'dn H'dle At the request of the Raceday Stewards, R.J. Condon, rider of Seeitoldya (GB), trained by Miss Ellmarie Holden, reported to the Stewards' Secretaries that his mount was off the bridle early and just stayed on.


