The Irish EBF Ballyhane Stakes (Median Auction Race) of €200,000

(Generously sponsored by Ballyhane Stud and the Irish EBF (€60,000)) Winner will receive €120,000 (Penalty Value: €118,500), Second will receive €40,000, Third will receive €20,000, Fourth will receive €10,000, Fifth will receive €6,000, Sixth will receive €4,000. For two years old only that are EBF eligible and whose sire established one or more yearling sales in the relevant year with a median price of not more than €75,000. Horses which do not have a registered name and have not been Returned In Training with a Licensed Trainer by Wednesday 23rd June will be automatically struck out of this race. (Please note for un-named horses trained in Ireland which were foaled in Britain or Ireland an acceptable naming application should be made to HRI by Thursday, 17th June and for all other un-named horses, naming forms should be submitted earlier as the naming process will take longer).

About 6 furlongs.

€250 to enter (plus €12.50 bookage fee),

€250 extra (plus €42.50 bookage fee), if forfeit not declared by May 26th,

€500 extra (plus €42.50 bookage fee), if forfeit not declared by June 23rd,

€500 extra (plus €42.50 bookage fee), if forfeit not declared by July 28th.

Weights: .....9st 8lb Fillies allowed.....5lb

Penalties - Winner of a Listed race ..... 5lb extra

Winner of a Group race..... 7lb extra

Allowances - (which are not cumulative)

If median price established by the sire is not more than €60,000 allowed .....2lb

If median price established by the sire is not more than €45,000 allowed .....4lb

If median price established by the sire is not more than €30,000 allowed .....6lb

If median price established by the sire is not more than €15,000 allowed .....8lb

Exclusions - Horses that have been purchased at Public Auction under the hammer for €200,000 or more at any time.

In order to facilitate those people wishing to make entries for this race, the Stewards of the I.H.R.B., using their powers under Rule 22, have suspended the appropriate paragraphs of the following Rules, Rule 103 (i), 106, 121, 122 and 194 (ii)(c). HRI Directive 10 is suspended for the purpose of this race. Should it be necessary to reduce the number of declared runners to the maximum runners, or to such a lesser number as may be required the following procedures shall be applied for the elimination and balloting of horses:- (i) Runners will first be reduced by balloting from among those horses that have not run. (ii) In the event of (i) not achieving the recommended limit runners will then be reduced by balloting from among those horses that, in the opinion of the Handicappers, have the lowest adjusted ratings (having regard to the applicable sex allowance). International performances will be taken into account. The latest date for calculation of ratings is 10 a.m. on Wednesday, 28th July.

The final two forfeit fees will be refunded to the owners of those horses that are eliminated from this race.

Nominators who do not have a current racing account should include cheque for €262.50 for each nomination.
