

The Directors of the IHRB using their powers under Rule 22 have approved the modification of Rule 91 with effect from January 1<sup>st</sup> 2022

The modifications are underlined or deletions indicated.

Administering and endorsing vaccinations

91.

(i) It shall be a breach of these Rules for any Horse to enter Racecourse Property on a designated Raceday unless it is certified by a veterinary surgeon as vaccinated against Equine Influenza in accordance with the following;

For Horses which have been vaccinated with a valid first vaccination before 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 the following shall apply:

1. Primary Course of Vaccination shall comprise of:
  - a. First vaccination;
  - b. Second vaccination between 21 and 92 days after the first;
  - c. Third vaccination between 150 and 215 days after the second.
2. Booster equine influenza vaccination administered at least on an annual basis until 1<sup>st</sup> January 2023 (or such lesser time as the IHRB may direct).

Or

For Horses which have been vaccinated with a valid first vaccination on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 the following shall apply:

1. Primary Course of Vaccination shall comprise of:
  - a. First vaccination;
  - b. Second vaccination between 21 and 60 days after the first;
  - c. Third vaccination between 120 and 180 days after the second.
2. Booster equine influenza vaccination administered within six months or such lesser time as the IHRB may direct.

No changes to the rest of the rule sections (ii) – (ix)
